What We Learned

Religion

- In 5th grade, students explored who Jesus is and how he impacted the world by sharing God's love and his mission with the Church.
- In 6th grade, they studied God's revelation and creation, discovering how God expresses himself through his wondrous creations, as well as through Scripture and Tradition. They examined the creation stories, recognizing God as the source of all life.
- In 7th/8th grade, students deepened their understanding of Jesus and his background. They also reflected on the importance of maintaining a relationship with Jesus, spending time contemplating the meaning of their friendship with him.
